

Call for Visiting Artists
Law and the Humanities Hub at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies (IALS),
School of Advanced Study, University of London

The Institute of Advanced Legal Studies at the School of Advanced Study, University of London invites applications from artists who explore law in their creative work, for a visiting position for the academic year 2024-2025. The visitor will be affiliated with a new Hub of Law and the Humanities (LHub) at IALS, become part of its founding collective, and contribute to its activity.

The visitorship is a unique opportunity to creatively imagine, explore and shape connections between Law and the Humanities through art, foster networks with researchers, and benefit from shared involvement in your creative projects.

The visiting artist will enjoy access to libraries and facilities at the School of Advanced Study, University of London, become part of the IALS community and remain an affiliate of LHub after their visitorship.

The visitorship position will be accompanied by an annual stipend of £1600 and travel reimbursement up to £500. It may be taken alongside any other position in the UK or abroad.

The visitorship will include:

- Three to four LHub days at IALS every term, which will take place on Tuesdays or Thursdays during [term dates](#). Each day will be a mix of group sessions and dedicated time for individual work in a common space. The first LHub day will take place on October 1, 2024.
- Significant contribution to one LHub project involving connections between law and art, to be discussed and agreed in advance.

To apply, please send a CV, a short statement about your planned project/s for the coming year (up to 400 words), and a short statement of interest (up to 400 words), to LHUB@sas.ac.uk, by September 8, 2024. Please also indicate if you are not available on either Tuesdays or Thursdays during term dates. Interviews will take place on September 17 and 18, 2024.
