TWIN/2/6 LLM Review, 1965-1993

Extent and form: 42 items

Scope and content: in 1992 William Twining was appointed by the University of London to review the intercollegiate LLM offered by Kings College, UCL, SOAS, LSE and Queen Mary College. These papers are the working and research papers reviewed and created by Prof Twining during the course of this project.

Appraisal: during the Records of Legal Education Archive project, the official papers relating

to the LLM Review were transferred to the archives of the University of London (UOL), the UOL being the commissioning and employing organisation for the LLM review. It was decided, in light of the small quantity of papers in question, to retain the remaining working papers and research notes as part of the Twining Archive in order to: ensure the completeness of that archive; to allow IALS to have a reference set of papers; and to ensure that there was a complete set of papers in existence, there not being time to cross check each document against the UOL holding. During the cataloguing of these papers in 2014 and 2015 this decision was revisited and ratified on the grounds that these papers would have potential research interest for the history of legal education and therefore, whilst not necessarily forming part of the UOL collecting policy, would fit with that of IALS.

In addition, obvious duplicates were deaccessioned during cataloguing (no attempt was made to weed out duplication between files). Papers relating to specific UCL students found amongst these records were also deaccessioned on the grounds that they were part of the UCL corporate record and retention policy, rather than research papers, and it was unclear whether they had been consulted during the LLM review.

Access: all items are open apart from TWIN/2/6/22 which is closed for 75 years under the Data Protection Act.

System of arrangement: no original order could be determined during cataloguing: these files had already been identified as relating to the LLM Review as part of the Records of Legal Education Archive Project. Files were arranged in chronological order during cataloguing.

Administrative history: in 1965 Prof Twining (then at the University of Warwick) and Robert Stevens (then at Tulane University, New Orleans) planned a new series of law books which would challenge existing textbook orthodoxy. The series became the "Law in Context" series. The aim of the series was to stimulate the writing of books which were broader in aim than traditional law text books, treating legal subjects from a broader base than in the past, using material from other social sciences, business studies and any other discipline that helped to explain the law in action in its social and economic context. The books were to be written with the needs of university students of law and related disciplines in mind. The publishers were Weidenfeld & Nicholson (Butterworths later took over publication of the series) and the editors were initially Prof Twining and Robert Stevens. They were later joined by Christopher McCrudden (University of Oxford). The first book was published in 1970.

The publishers had final say on what was accepted whilst the editors made recommendations on the basis of proposals submitted either direct to them or forwarded on from publishers. The editors were not involved with contracts between the authors and publishers nor in related legal matters. However, there was a great deal of discussion regarding publicity and distribution of the volumes.

Appraisal: as part of the Records of Legal Education Archive project: publishers' proofs, duplicate material, drafts, routine correspondence, published material unless directly relevant were recommended for destruction. Policy, development, notes of meetings, comments, and one copy of each LIC catalogue/pamphlet were recommended for retention.
